Re: Foreign Military Vessel Security Zone

1. The U.S. Coast Guard Captain of the Port (COTP) is establishing a temporary security zone from October 19, 2018 through October 26, 2018. The security zone will cover all navigable waters within Sector New York COTP Zone, extending from the surface to bottom, within a 100-yard radius of HMS QUEEN ELIZABETH whether underway, at berth, or anchored in approximate position 40-40.04'N 074-02.4'W (see chartlet below for Bay Ridge Anchorage location). The security zone is intended to protect the vessel and the public while the foreign military vessel is within the COTP New York zone.
2. The size of the security zone can be increased or decreased as deemed necessary by the COTP.
3. No vessel or person shall enter the security zone without specific authorization from the Coast Guard COTP or a designated representative. A designated representative means a Coast Guard Patrol Commander, including a Coast Guard coxswain, petty officer, or other officer operating a Coast Guard vessel and a Federal, State, and local officer designated by or assisting the COTP in the enforcement of the security zone. Other law enforcement agencies will assist the Coast Guard in maintaining the security zone.
4. To seek authorization for entry into this security zone, contact the COTP or the COTP's representative via VHF channel 16 or by phone at (718) 354-4353. Those in the security zone must comply with all lawful orders or directions given to them by the COTP or the COTP's designated representative


